Contents History AutoCAD is Autodesk's flagship software product for 2D and 3D CAD. Although AutoCAD has roots in the 1960s, the product was originally an in-house project by Autodesk. In 1974, Autodesk acquired a small program called AutoCAD (as of this writing, it had a price tag of \$5,500), and it was first released in December 1982 as a desktop app on IBM mainframe computers or minicomputers. AutoCAD was created by John Walker and Karl Swanson as a replacement for AutoLISP. The first release in the early 1980s was the first commercial product based on AutoCAD. In 1984, Autodesk re-released the software as AutoCAD for the IBM PC. It was the first time that CAD software was available for PC users. The first widely distributed software with multiple editions (released in October 1984) was AutoCAD II. By the mid-1990s, Autodesk was experiencing rapid growth and by 1996, the company was the world's fastest growing software company. The company had the highest per-share earnings for a software company and was ranked among the world's most innovative software companies by BusinessWeek. In August 1998,

Autodesk released AutoCAD 2000, which had been under development for four years. By the beginning of 2003, Autodesk had 65,000 employees. That year, the company generated a gross profit of \$1.2 billion, and it earned \$42 per share in profit for shareholders. By the end of 2003, the company generated a \$10 billion gross profit and a \$1.8 billion profit for shareholders. The company reported a 48% increase in revenues to \$3.1 billion in 2003. At the same time, Autodesk posted its first quarterly loss of \$82 million. Marketing Early distribution of Autodesk products was focused on large corporations, and Autodesk's distribution channel was primarily through third-party software vendors. Autodesk began marketing Autodesk in 1984. In 2004, Autodesk launched its first full-time advertising campaign, with two advertisements made by TBWA/Chicago. Autodesk had hired Boris Borisov to manage the creative aspect of the campaign. In 2007, Autodesk launched a U.S. television advertising campaign to promote the 2010 version of AutoCAD
