To describe the rare case of Churg-Strauss syndrome (CSS) presenting as renal involvement in a young male patient. A 23-year-old man presented with weakness, malaise, weight loss and facial edema in October 2005. He had an elevated erythrocyte sedimentation rate (51 mm/1 h) and a decreased renal function. A biopsy of the right renal parenchyma revealed necrotizing crescentic glomerulonephritis. Laboratory studies revealed a low C3 (29 mg/dl) and elevated soluble vascular cell adhesion molecule-1 (SVCAM-1) levels. A diagnosis of CSS was established and he was treated with pulse cyclophosphamide, oral steroids and immunosuppressive therapy. Renal function improved with reduced proteinuria. A repeat biopsy in February 2007 showed a slightly improved histological picture. CSS is a rare systemic vasculitis of unknown etiology. CSS generally affects young males and it is often associated with asthma, allergic rhinitis and extra-cardiac symptoms. Renal involvement is the most severe presentation of CSS and is rarely reported in the literature.
